Eligibility/Standards: This is a juried fine arts and fine crafts fair. All work must be original by the artist, who must be age 18 or older. No molds, manufactured or kit art permitted. Commercial reproductions (editions of 300 or less) may be included in your exhibit if they do not exceed 50% of the total display and if they are clearly marked as reproductions. Final interpretation of commercial status will be made by jurors.

Application: We encourage you to apply online through www.artsinbartlett.org. However, this paper application is an alternative for those who are unable to process slides digitally and/or upload images. For a \$15 extra processing fee, Arts in Bartlett will process your slides/CD images on your behalf and put your application online for you. You must provide a \$40 check by March 15 with this form, your CD or slides to Arts in Bartlett, PO Box 8393, Bartlett IL 60103.

Please submit four slides or high-resolution digital images on a CD-ROM or by email to artsinbartlett@comcast.net (three representing the work you are bringing and one of your display booth). Be sure that your slides show a consistent body of work. Mail or e-mail an artist statement with your experience and an explanation of your creative process.

Groups of artists are accepted, however, each artist in the group is juried separately. Each in a group application must pay the jury fee and submit 3 slides/images of his or her work. Only accepted artists can be part of the group exhibit. Please submit images and applications for a group in one package.

Fees: Pay online at www.artsinbartlett.org or by check made out to Arts in Bartlett and mailed to PO Box 8393, Bartlett IL 60103.

Invited, jury-exempt artists: early bird space fee if paid by March 1 -- \$100.

Artists to be juried: \$25 nonrefundable jury fee per artist plus a \$15 service fee for a paper application. Space fees due May 1 \$125 per juried artist or \$150 for a group, which is payable after you have been notified of acceptance. Late fee after May 1, add \$25 surcharge.

Timeline:

March 1: Early bird Space fee due for Invited jury-exempt artists (\$100)

March 15: Postmark deadline for paper applications (\$40 jury fee) or online application on www.artsinbartlett.org (\$25 jury fee)

March 25: Online application deadline

April 15: Jurying completed and artists notified

May 1: Booth fee payment due

May 15: Last day for cancellation refund

Exhibition: A 10 x 10 ft. space is allotted to each artist or group of artists with 2 ft. on either side of the space. All artists must supply their own booth structures, as well as display boards, tables and chairs. Exhibitors will be limited to 65 to give each artist maximum exposure.

Artists are responsible for set-up of their booths, which must be installed by 9:30 a.m. on June 27. Friday night setup after 6:30 pm is allowed. Artists are required to remain set up until closing at 5 p.m. both days. Artists must be present, no dealer/agents stand-ins. No commission is charged.

Liability: Each artist assumes full responsibility for the care, safety and security of his/her works and property. Security is provided Friday and Saturday night. However, by signing the application form, each artist agrees that Arts in Bartlett is not responsible for the loss or damage to works and waives any claim from any cause.

Awards: Best of Show, Mayor's Choice, 1st & 2nd 2-D and 3-D, Awards of Excellence, and Purchase Awards, are presented Saturday afternoon, June 27. People's Choice Award is awarded Sunday afternoon.

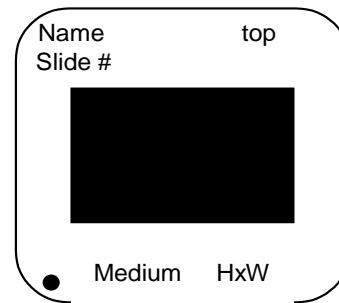

For paper applications, each artist (individual or those in groups) must submit three standard 35 mm color slides with cardboard or plastic mounts or three digital high resolution images, which are representative of media to be exhibited, and one slide or image of the group or individual display. Each slide should be numbered and labeled in the top right corner and include the artist's name, medium and size. Do not apply tape to slides. Slides or CDs of artists not accepted will be returned if a self-addressed, stamped envelope (SASE) is included.
